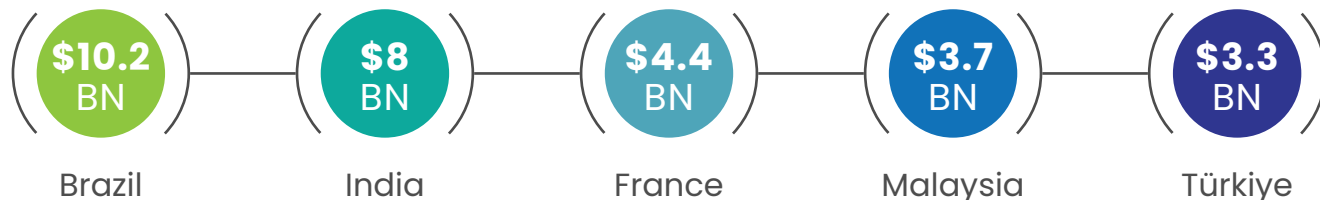

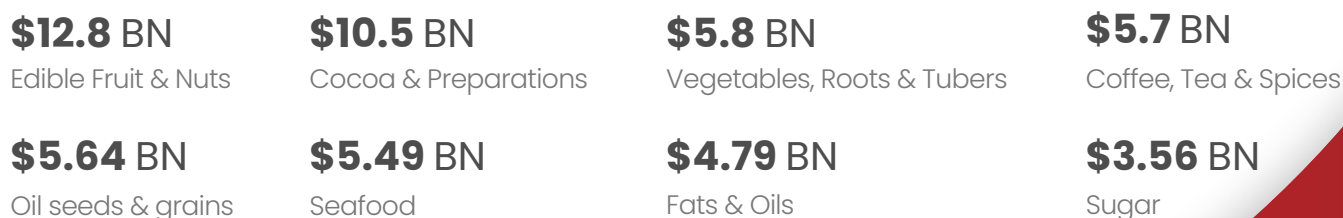

Top 5 Exporting Countries for Food & Beverages to Africa



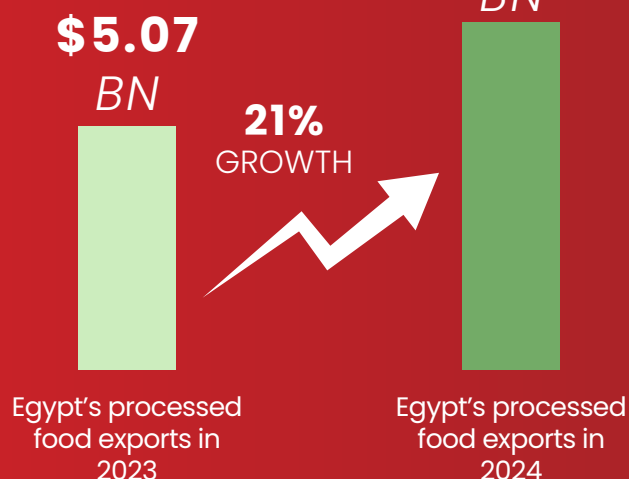
Top Food & Beverage Exports from Africa

Top Food Imports in Egypt in 2023



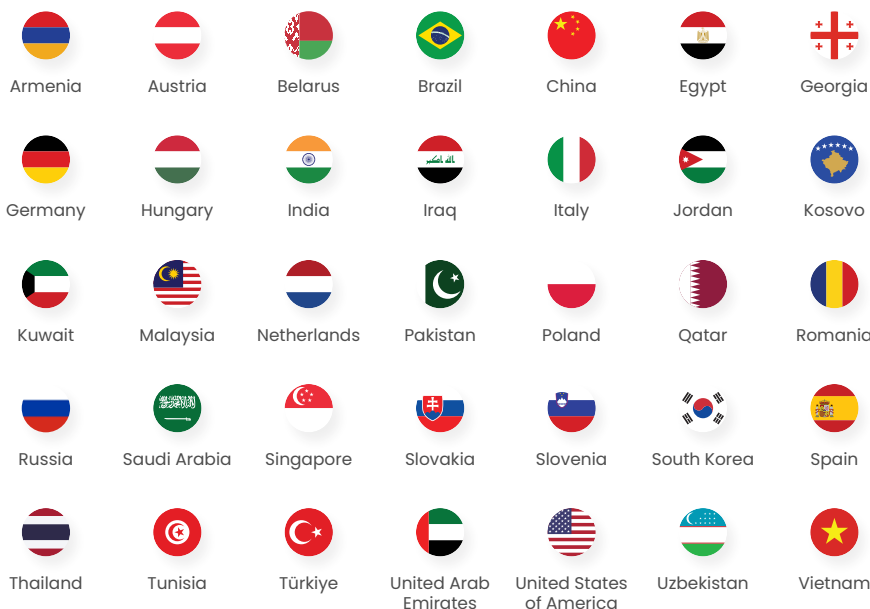
Top Exporting Countries to Egypt in 2023
